

Instructions for the replication files for “The Structure of Tariffs and Long-Term Growth”, *American Economic Journal: Macroeconomics*, by Nathan Nunn and Daniel Trefler.

The zipped folder contains the following do files:

1. AEJ_Macro_tables.do – this do file performs all of the calculations and estimations in the tables and footnotes of the paper, except for the robustness estimates of table 11.
2. AEJ_Macro_table_11.do – this performs the estimates reported in table 11 of the paper.
3. AEJ_Macro_graphs.do – this creates all of the graphs of the paper.

The do files draw from the following dta files which are also in the folder.

1. AEJ_Macro_data_final.dta
2. AEJ_Macro_data_no_agriculture_final.dta
3. AEJ_Macro_data_all_cutoffs_US_rankings_final.dta
4. AEJ_Macro_data_all_cutoffs_south_africa_rankings_final.dta
5. AEJ_Macro_data_all_cutoffs_brazil_rankings_final.dta

To replicate the results of the paper, simply unzip the folder containing all of the files. Then double click on each of the three do files. This will execute the do files. All that is required is that the dta files are in the same folder as the do files. When each do file runs, it will create a log file with all of the results. The do file “AEJ_Macro_graphs.do” will save the graphs as eps files in the same folder.
